

Business Club trip to Brazil and Dubai

Q. When is the trip?

A. The trip is from April 7th to April 19th 2018

Q. When is the deadline for registration and payment?

A. Close of registration and payment will be Friday March 16th 2018

Q. What is the cost of the trip?

A. The trip is open to both Business Club Members and Non-Club customers. The cost is as indicated below:

Business Club Members	
Sharing	USD 3800
Single	USD 4500

Non-Club Members (customers can join the Business Club to be eligible for the rate above).	
Sharing	USD 3950
Single	USD 4650

The cost will cover the following:

- Visa processing for Brazil and Dubai
- Flight fare Nairobi - Sao Paulo - Rio De Janeiro- Dubai - Nairobi
- Airport transfers, taxes and transport on the ground as per the itinerary
- 5 nights accommodation in 5-star hotel on bed and breakfast basis in Sao Paulo
- 3 nights accommodation in 4-star superior hotel on bed and breakfast in Rio De Janeiro
- 2 nights accommodation in 5-star hotel on bed and breakfast in Dubai
- Professional guide and translator
- Dinner at world famous Fogo De Chao
- Expo entrance fees

Q. Can I start paying in installments?

A. Yes, you can start making payments for the trip in installments until the final payment deadline of March 16th 2018.

Q. What documents are required to register for the trip and for visa processing?

1. Valid passport for at least six months (the Consular Section of the Embassy reserves the right not to endorse soiled, damaged or defaced passports).
2. 2 recent passport-sized (3x4 cm) photographs (Normal size) The photo must be a full-face front view on a clear white background
3. Original 6 month stamped personal Bank statements, payment slips and credit card statements are accepted as proof. Company statement can used to boost the application.
4. Genuine Certificate of vaccination (Yellow Fever)
5. Letter from the business/Employer on a letter head, stamped and signed
6. Certificate of incorporation/Registration, Memorandum of association or CR12

PLEASE NOTE:

- The requirements listed above should not, in any way, be considered all inclusive. The Consular Section of the Brazilian Embassy in Nairobi reserves the right to request additional information and/or documentation when they are deemed necessary.
- That this Consular Section DOES NOT provide express or emergency visa services.
- When filling in the manifest please check DATE OF BIRTH, because this information MUST perfectly match those on your passport.
- Whenever applicable and according to the regulations, only ORIGINAL documents are acceptable; NO scans, NO emails, NO colorful copies, NO electronic signed document.
- That issuing or denying a visa is a sovereign act of Governments. It is a prerogative applied by every country and strengthened by international practice

Q. Does the customer need to be physically present at the Embassy for the visas?

A. No the customer will not need to be present for an interview at the embassy

Q. Are there any loans available to customers to fund this trip?

A. Family Bank does not have a loan facility for the sole purpose for Business Club trips. However, if the customer already has an existing facility they can request for a top-up.

Q. How will medical and health-related matters while on the trip be handled?

A. Family Bank will take out travel insurance for all customers on the trip to cater for any medical emergencies.

Q. If customers were to make purchases during the trip (other than the maximum allowable cargo by the airline used), how will shipping will be facilitated?

A. Family Bank will provide you contacts of shipping agents to facilitate transport. This shipping cost will be borne by the customer.
