Kenya Shilling: With too many shillings chasing too few dollars, the local currency has weakened considerably against the US currency, signaling a rise in inflation and a higher cost of imported goods.

Money-Market: The overnight rate closed at 5.1796% on a volume of 31.470Bn compared to 5.1582% on a volume of Kes.25.965Bn posted in the previous session.

Global Trends:

EUR: The euro edged higher against dollar on Thursday as investors assessed the impact of possible new tightening measures at next week's European Central Bank policy meeting.

GBP: Sterling initially gained on Thursday but reversed course as UK Prime Minister Liz Truss announced her resignation just six weeks after she was appointed.


JPY: The dollar hit the symbolic level of 150 yen for the first time since 1990 on Thursday as the greenback was supported by Treasury yields trading at multi-year highs, keeping markets on high alert for intervention from Japanese authorities.

GOLD: Gold prices pared gains on Thursday, having risen about 1% on a softer dollar, as a jump in equities markets and rallying Treasury yields pulled bullion back toward three-week lows hit earlier.

OIL: Oil prices were near flat during a choppy trading session on Thursday, as worries about inflation dampening demand for oil contended with news that China is considering easing COVID-19 quarantine measures for visitors.

Highlights of the Day:

USD: In trade on Thursday, the US dollar and US bond yields rose, with the US 2-year topping the highest since 2008 at 4.614%. Federal Reserve Bank of Philadelphia President Patrick Harker who said the central bank is not done with raising its short-term rate target amid very high levels of inflation. His most hawkish of remarks sent yields to fresh cycle highs, the strongest in a decade. He said the Fed has made disappointing progress at lower inflation and added that inflation in 2023 would fall to around 4% and 2.5% in 2024, which is still well above the 2%.

Sub-Saharan African banks are increasingly worried about funding costs, an annual survey published on Wednesday found, as soaring interest rates both on the continent and globally make financing more expensive.
